The RR team schedule 2021 has their first match fixed on the 12<sup>th</sup> of April. It is going to be the 4<sup>th</sup> day of the tournament. They will be going up against the Punjab Kings (Previously named as the Kings XI Punjab). The match will begin at 7:30 PM IST and will be played at the iconic Wankhede Stadium in Mumbai. RR will be looking to have a positive start to the tournament. It is obvious that the first match is always very crucial for a team's momentum and morale.

## RR Team History

Rajasthan Royals were the first-ever champions of the Indian Premier League. They won the very first edition of the tournament back in 2008. The opponents in the final were the Chennai Super Kings, but Rajasthan Royals came out on top and took the trophy home.

Unfortunately, afterward, it has only been downhill for the team from Rajasthan. They have failed to qualify for the final in any of the other seasons after the inaugural one, and have qualified for the playoffs only thrice.

In the 2009 edition, they finished at the 3<sup>rd</sup> last spot, I.E., at the sixth position. One year later, they were at the 2nd last. The same two positions repeated for the next two years. RR finished at the 6<sup>th</sup> spot in 2011, and at the 7<sup>th</sup> in 2012. Finally, they qualified for the playoffs in 2013 but failed to go past the 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

2014 was another disappointing year for the Rajasthani fans as their team got eliminated once again in the group stage. They went to the playoffs in 2015, but couldn't go all the way. Afterward, the team got suspended in a spot-fixing case in the same year, alongside CSK. As a consequence, they did not play the 2016 and 2017 editions of the Indian Premier League.

Rajasthan Royals returned in 2018 and again got knocked out of the playoffs as the 4<sup>th</sup> best team. Lastly, the last two years have been very poor for them. 2019 saw them finishing at the 7<sup>th</sup>, and 2020 was their worst year in history as they got out of the tournament ending at the last 8<sup>th</sup> spot.

## RR Team Coaches

Rajasthan Royals have part ways with their head coach Andrew McDonald. However, no need to worry because the all-time great, Kumar Sangakkara, who is currently the team director, is expected to step in the shoes of the head coach as well.

With Kumar, Trevor Penney will be his assistant coach. On the other hand, Sairaj Bahutule is the spin-bowling coach of the team, and Rob Cassell is the fast-bowling coach. Dishant Yagnik is serving the duty as the fielding coach of the Rajasthan Royals squad 2021. Lastly, Amol Mazumdar, who was the batting coach of the team in the last tenure is now the "out-of-season High-Performance Batting coach" of the Rajasthan team.
